Boys & Girls Clubs of the North Valley (BGCNV) is a private 501(c)3 non-profit organization formed in 1995 to provide comprehensive youth development services, activities and programs for youth in the northstate region. It is governed by a local board of volunteer directors, staffed by over 70 youth development professionals and supported by over 500 community volunteers. BGCNV currently serves more than 2,000 youth and operates 10 sites, throughout Butte & Glenn Counties, where members, ages 6 to 18, can access a variety of quality services in Academics, Health & Wellness and Character and Leadership programs.

Established in 1993, Habitat for Humanity of Butte County is an independent 501(c)3 non-profit and one of more than 1500 local Habitat for Humanity affiliates in the United States that work with local volunteers to build safe affordable homes with hardworking eligible families. Habitat homeowners help build their own homes alongside volunteers, work 250 sweat equity hours, and pay a low-interest affordable mortgage.

This past year in Paradise, we completed seven homes. Five of the families were impacted by the 2018 Camp Fire. We have much to celebrate, but still more to build! Our goal for 2023 is to complete 8 houses.

CHIP is a private, non-profit 501(c)(3) corporation serving Butte, Glenn, Tehama, Shasta, Sutter, Yuba and Colusa counties. We assist low-income and rural disadvantaged residents, seniors and others who lack financial resources or knowledge to improve or provide adequately for their housing. Here's what we do:

- Construct mutual self-help (sweat equity) housing and affordable multi-family apartment housing
- Construct multi-family apartment communities for low- and very-low income residents utilizing a variety of local, State, Federal, and private funding sources.
- Manage rental properties we build and properties owned by others (18 properties total)
- Provide education and services to residents
- Build and enhance communities



Paradise Recreation and Park District (PRPD) is an independent special district serving over 50,000 individuals in the Sierra Nevada foothills of Northern California, approximately 90 miles north of Sacramento. PRPD maintains 73 acres of developed park land and another 358 acres of natural open space. Park facilities include swimming pools, fishing pond, play fields, horse arena, archery range, ropes course, walking trails, picnic areas, tennis courts, playgrounds, open use areas, and a recreation center.
